VCE students will be eligible for two units of credit towards their VCE at Units 1 and 2 level.

VCAL:

This Certificate will satisfy learning outcomes for the Industry Specific Skills and work related strands in the VCAL program.

WORK PLACEMENT:

A minimum of 10 days work placement is recommended by the VCAA.

ORIENTATION:

For students enrolling at the HDSC for the first time a compulsory Information Session will be held during their first session in Term 1, 2023.
